Programme Components

Component A: *Sustainable management of critical habitats*

- Management planning and implementation

- Effluents are collected, treated, recycled and/or disposed of in accordance with international best practices



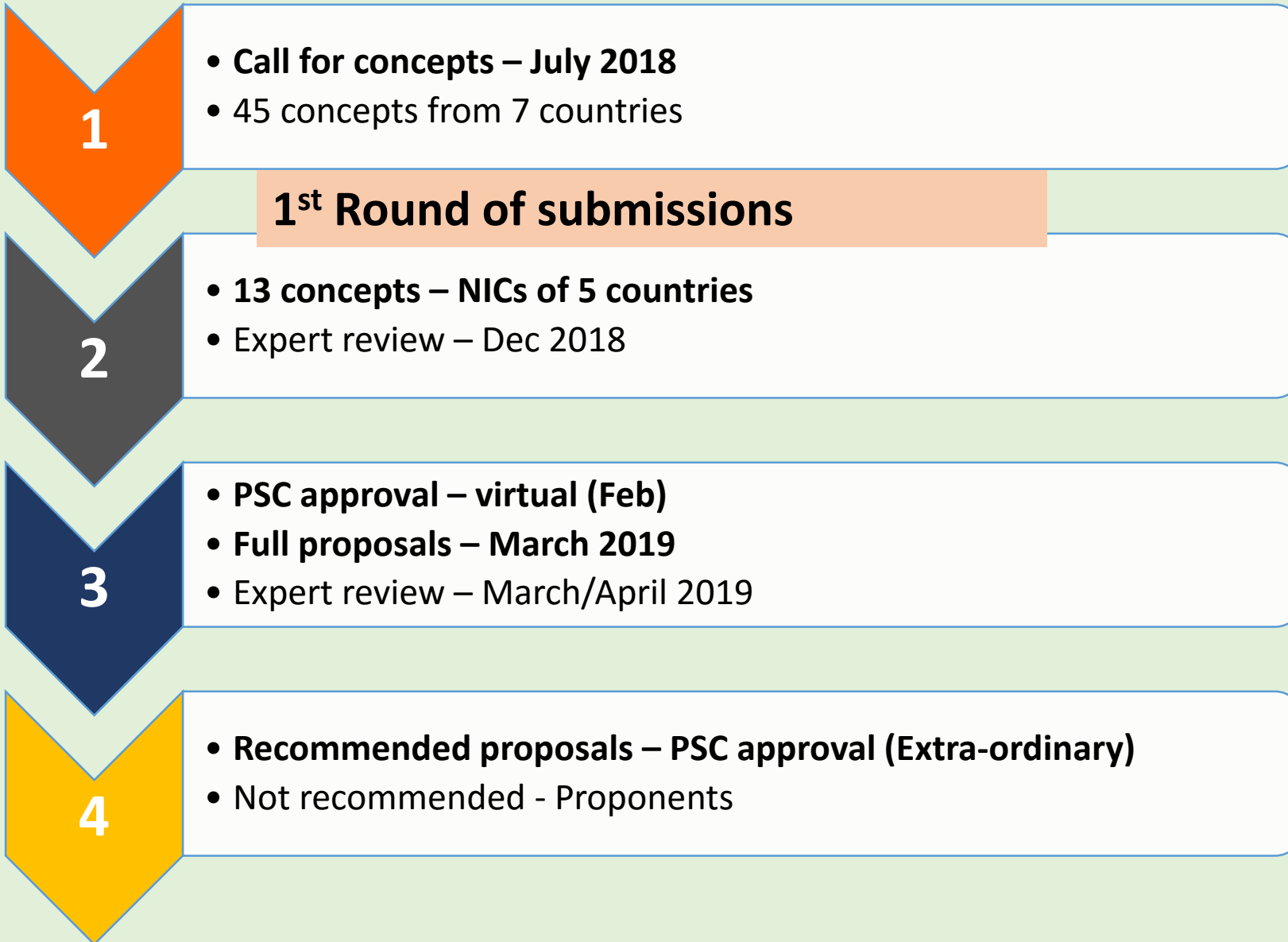
Component C: *Sustainable management of river flows*

- Call for concepts: Background doc and template
- Partner submissions to PMU and Focal Point
- Convening of NIC: Criteria
- Concepts to be reviewed by at least 3 competent experts
- Presentation by proponents for clarity
- Evaluation by NIC
- Recommendation and prioritization
- 3 qualifying concepts submitted to PMU per a country with supporting NIC report: additional qualifying concepts maintained by FP.....
- PMU screening
- Regional Experts: Technical criteria
- PSC

Summary of proposal development



2nd Round



Process summary

- Thirteen concepts were approved by PSC for full proposal development in Feb 2019
- PMU invited full proposals with a dateline of one month till 5th of March 2019
- Twelve full proposals were submitted, while one from Seychelles wasn't submitted from the originally recommended concepts
- Madagascar requested major technical support in developing two of its proposals and thus only 10 proposals were subjected to regional expert review
- Eight proposals were approved by the May 2019 Extraordinary PSC: two were under review

Recent developments

- Two under review/devtpt proposals from Seychelles and S. Africa on water quality now submitted
- Already gotten experts to support Madagascar and Comoros in the development of proposals (2 for Madagascar and one for Comoros)
- PSC gave virtual approval of concepts from Tanzania and Mozambique to proceed to full proposal development – 15/07/2019
- The 8 proposals approved by PSC on May 27th to be presented for full reporting and endorsement before funding consideration
