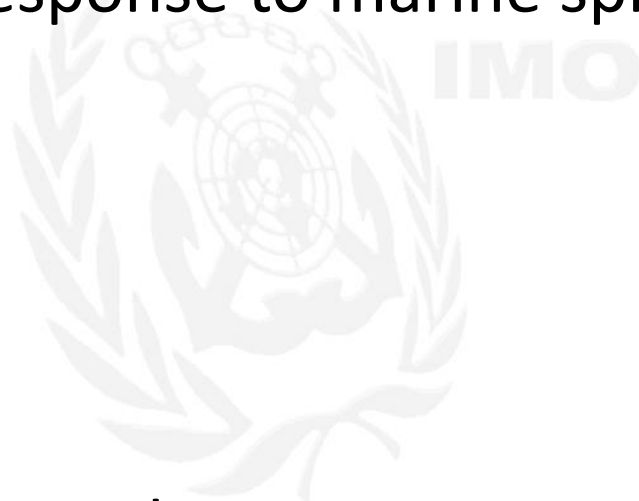

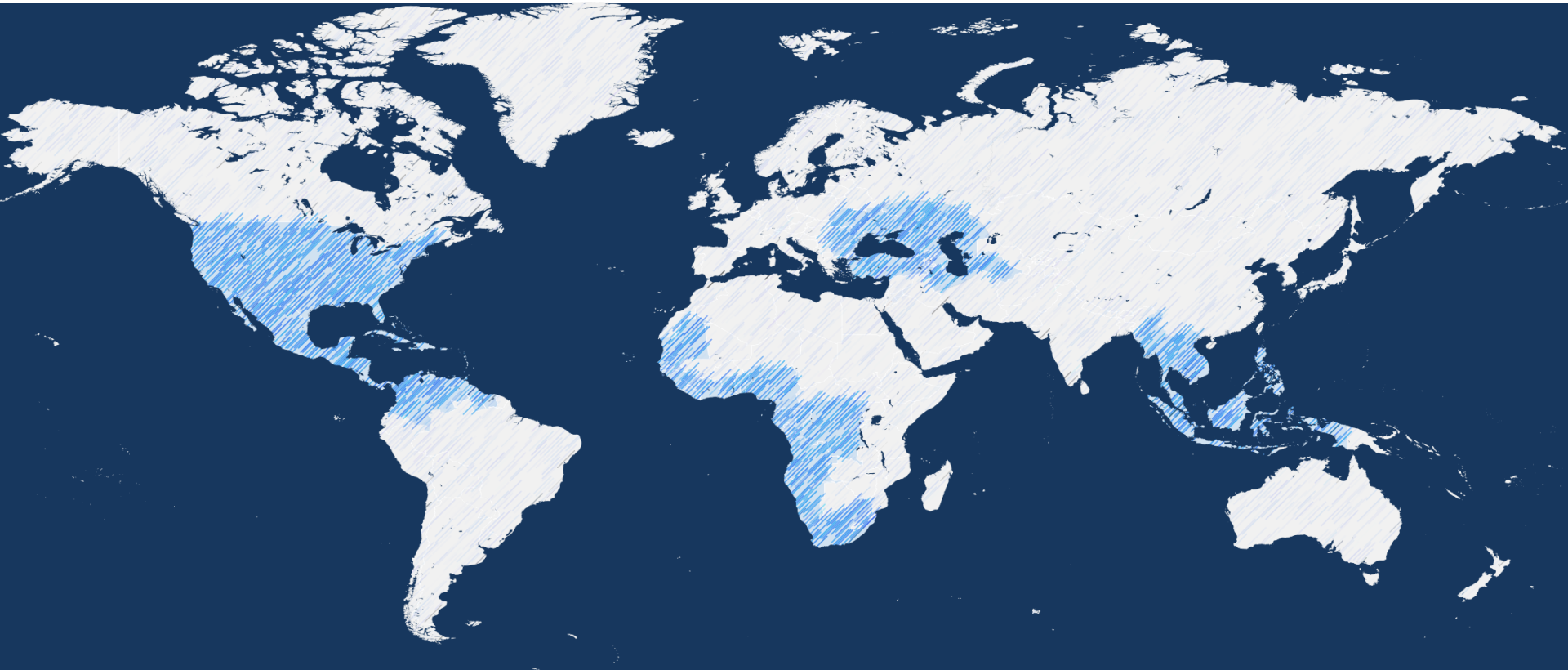
# Integrated Technical Cooperation Programme (ITCP)

- Administered by the Technical Cooperation Division
- Regional and Global Programmes
- Focussed on countries specified needs
  - Member State Audit, Country Maritime Profile and specific requests for assistance
- Resourced by Technical Cooperation Fund & Donor Countries
- Evaluation and follow-up by Internal Oversight and Ethics Office

# ITCP and OPRC

- OPRC: Main focus is effective implementation through the development of guidance documents, training materials and capacity building activities and projects
- Global Initiative Programme partnership with oil industry in a number of regions globally.
- Collaboration with regional partners/centres to implement national / sub-regional workshops and training courses
- Sponsorship of participants to international conferences
- Cooperation and coordination with other programmes/organizations and projects with a similar remit to ensure consistency in approach and avoid duplication and confusion

# IMO – IPIECA Global Initiative



- Successful Programme- working together to improve oil spill preparedness and response in many regions of the world
- In excess of **200 workshops** over a combined **35 years** of program experience of building capacity in **43** countries.
- In GI-WACAF alone there have been **113 activities** engaging with **5904 participants**, since 2006

# The Global Initiative for West, Central, and Southern Africa (GI WACAF)

- **Launch:** 2006
- **Goal:** Enhance oil spill response capability in West Central, and Southern Africa
- **Scope:** organise trainings, exercises and workshops
- **Area:** Covers 22 countries
- **Annual funding**
  - Funding from IMO
  - Funding from IPIECA: 7 oil industries members

# OPRC activities in the WIO region

- Recent years: Support to UN Environment - Oil for Development Partnership project in relation to emergency preparedness and Response, through the implementation of regional activities on:
  - OPRC training courses
  - Shoreline response training courses
  - Strengthening oil spill contingency planning
  - Planning a future activity on liability and compensation for oil spills
- In the past IMO supported the implementation of the West Indian Ocean Marine Highway Development and Coastal and Marine Contamination Prevention Project
