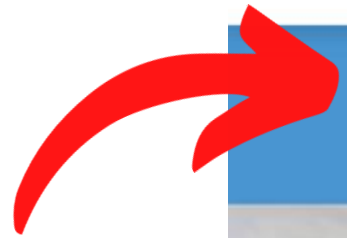


Logging in after registration and activation
