Is MSP being implemented?

The MSP is a new concept for the Comoros, Currently it is in an embryonic state.

From which year did implementation begin?

In November 2021, we held the first workshop on the preparation of the action plan on the MSP under the funded by UNESCO-IOC

Workshop objectives

• Introduce MSP into the legal and technical framework, while linking it to Integrated Coastal Zone Management.

• Provide participants with a common context for implementing MSP/PSM in the Union of Comoros including tools to leverage

Specific objectives

- Start the process of preparing the MSP in the Comoros
- Media awareness on the MSP process
- Introduce MSP to participants
- Discuss the technical and legal aspects of MSP
- Map stakeholders and assign roles
- Conceptualize the MSP process
- Define a road map for the initial MSP activities in 2022 as an Action Plan.

Key Authorities/ Institutional Framework

National Competent Authority:

- The workshop participants agreed that: The General Planning Commission (CGP) is the authority that will be responsible for coordinating, supervising and monitoring all the phases of preparation and implementation of the MSP.
- Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and the Environment

key governmental authorities involved:

Ministries of foreign affairs, education, maritime transport, regional planning, economy and finance, justice, interior, University of the Comoros

stakeholders involved:

National Office of Tourism, National Agency for Maritime Affairs (ANAM), DGPSN (General Directorate of Police and National Security), General Directorate of Fisheries Resources, National Directorate of Infrastructure, Comoros National Parks (PNC)ect

Supporting Legal and Policy Framework

- No strategic plan is being developed at this time
- No working group or national committee has been set up
- The policy exists but not for the MSP context, rather on blue economy and conservation

Practical Application in the countries

The MSP will be applied in marine protected areas in the context of conservation and the blue economy

Conclusion

- The Union of the Comoros will be able to launch its process of preparing the MSP
- There are sufficient skills among the sectors
- ➤ We will have to organize ourselves around an Expert /Consultant (as coordinator) to start the proper process of implementing the MSP
- The process will take into account 3 areas Environment, Social, Economy together with a group in charge of GIS and all information related to the process
