Backstopping Contracting Parties in implementing COP10 decisions, the development of approaches to ocean financing and ocean governance.

Harnessing multi-stakeholder partnerships in contributing to improved ocean governance, pursuit of sustainable blue economy, marine spatial planning (MSP), reducing and mitigating the impacts of underwater noise.

Strengthening partnership in the implementation of projects/mainstreaming strategic interventions into Covid-19 recovery.
