GIZ currently hosts the secretariat of the Our Blue Future Initiative, a multi-stakeholder initiative established, after a CoP10 decision, to enhance coastal and ocean stewardship to accelerate the transition to an inclusive and sustainable blue economy (ISBE). Our overarching vision is a healthy, prosperous and resilient WIO region for the benefit of communities, businesses and ecosystems.

We aim to achieve this by supporting a wide diversity of partners to:

- Build capacity of partners and key stakeholders to deliver on ISBE solutions.
- Identify, develop and implement impactful partnerships and projects
- Mobilise resources and investments
- Engage in joint advocacy and awareness raising

Some of WIOGI's achievements to note so far include.

- OBF has 26 partners from government, private sector, civil society and international organisations.
- OBF has established sector-focused Innovation Teams including; Blue Tourism, Community Livelihoods, Circular Economy, Ports and Shipping, Fisheries and Blue Finance to support these sectors' innovate and transition to an ISBE.
- Private sector engagement through technical dialogues and exchange forums to evaluate the needs of our partners and stakeholders and how to best support them
- Support to ProAzul, the Government of Mozambique Blue Economy Fund, to mainstream gender and diversify its portfolio
- Establishment of Friends of Maputo National Park Club, to engage private sector in collectively funding and up-scaling nature-based solutions in the marine reserve.

- Strengthening intermediaries to provide ISBE services to micro, small and medium sized-enterprises across the region.
