
What would be added benefits of a regional IMS?


Technical

- ✓ One-stop source of information regarding ocean management decisions and available information
- ✓ Analytical and visualization options to put observations in context
- ✓ Standardized and interoperable data management and sharing – between institutions and across borders

Political

- ✓ Improved governance in multi-stakeholder environments
- ✓ Same information sources across institutions and borders – shared efforts
- ✓ Reduced costs and efforts one portal with an open interface to submit and access information

Steps in the development process

Participatory Strategy Development

Co-Create an information management strategy that provides the technical and political foundation for the implementation of the IM System

Plan and implement the IM System

Jointly deliver a system that collects information in a uniform way from all NC programmes and projects and presents them in a transparent and meaningful way to all users

Ensure Integration of National IM Efforts

Ensure alignment with, and contribution to, reporting duties of Nairobi Convention Member Countries

Capacity Development

Provide, develop and share the necessary capacities.

Key components

Thorough network / stakeholder analysis

Information needs assessment

Knowledge of existing information management systems / initiatives

Data sharing (Technical and political)

Capacity development strategy


