


#### **Covid-19 - Impact Assessment**

- Surveys, audits, grantees meetings and progress reports








## Impact of Covid-19 on Research projects

- Drastic reduction in field activities in the Ocean
- The effect on research activities is asymmetric.
- projects that require interaction with stakeholders, field sampling, etc., have had to postpone these activities
- Pre-existing vulnerabilities have only compounded the impact of the pandemic
- Drop in research output 40% (data gaps)

#### Impact of Covid-19 on Policy



- Conferences and workshops postponed to a later date to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Regional cooperation processes (e.g. Kenya-Tanzania TBCA meetings) have been disrupted by the pandemic, as many countries have prioritized national measures to contain COVID-19.

# WIOMSA support to research to minimize impact of COVID-19 on ongoing projects



- Considering budget adjustments and reallocations for research projects
- Commission research on impacts of Covid-19 (2 projects ongoing on pandemic, people and environment)
- Work with regional scientists to produce guidelines on how to prevent/mitigate COVID-19 during field operations
- Include covid and community considerations in new research projects and proposals
- Provide online training for practitioners' e.g. MPA staff; where training is not online, train in small groups
- Strengthen within-country activities and enhance knowledge crosstransfer

#### **Proposals to WIO Governments**



- Governments to consider research as essential service and include research institutions in stimulus packages and other financial support.
- Ocean research and action should not come to a halt while we tackle the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Increase data gathering on impact of covid to inform policies and for assessing impact of policies
- Accelerate digital transformation and enhance data sharing
- equip scientists with new skills to ensure that they have tools they need to support virtual meetings and workshops
- Reduce cross-border restrictions and enhance cooperation for science and policy processes
