

Full Protection Zones

The Protection Zones comprise significant areas in terms of the protection and conservation of systems and natural values of significant importance or in need of total protection, and their management objectives are priority over any other uses, activities and functions.

Qualified Areas

Qualified Zones result from legal impositions, or administrative acts, which have the public utility as their objective, and which may result in prohibitions or limitations.

Areas of Existing uses, activities and functions

Are all those areas that are reserved for a certain use, activity or function, developed under the Private Use of National Maritime Space (TUPEM) or Land Use and Benefit Rights (DUAT) titles, in the case of coastal zone, or other titles or commitments for private use issued under previous legislation
