






We need a virtuous cycle in which people, economies and nature thrive




We partner to deliver value through four key functions:

- 1. Common ISBE agenda: advocacy and awareness for blueeconomy policy, investment, business and society.
- 2. Enhanced ISBE capacity: training, effective learning, pooled expertise, incubators and new connections.
- Joint resource mobilisation: levering diverse technical expertise for local solutions, matching and mobilising funding and access to financing mechanisms.
- 4. Multi-stakeholder projects: joint project identification, incubation and implementation for sustainable enterprises, value chains, technologies, livelihoods and infrastructure.

The initiative seeks to build sustainable and impactful enterprises to meaningfully contribute to and support the development and long-term security of a sustainable and inclusive blue economy across the SWIO region.



Starting with a minimum-viable-product (MVP), a bespoke regional Venture Builder will aim to facilitate, support and bring to scale coastal sustainable livelihood businesses that sustain, protect and restore the marine and coastal ecosystems.



The programme will offer both financial and technical support to **first build a pipeline of financially sustainable** coastal community-led sustainable marine and coastal enterprises, then
explore appropriate opportunities to **develop them further to investment-readiness**.



The aim is to help to build capacity and unlock finance at-scale for the region's underserved MSMEs whilst supporting the development and scaling of a sustainable blue economy across the region



This seeks to build on, add value and leverage existing activities of key NGOs and support organisations in this region, and seek to align, expand, and deploy existing Innovation Support Organisations (ISOs) and Entrepreneurial Support Organisations (ESOs).

Taking a participatory approach to create solid foundations






We are setting goals with tangible impacts:
