#### ZANZIBAR

 Zanzibar is semi-autonomous part of the United Republic of Tanzania (URT) which consists of two major islands (Unguja and Pemba) and a number of small islets in the East Coast of African continent. Within the URT framework, the Revolutionary Government of Zanzibar (RGZ) has full mandate over the management of the fisheries located in its internal waters

#### Zanzibar count...


• The total area of both islands is 2,643 km2 (Unguja 1,658 km2 Pemba 985 km2). The population is estimated to be around 1.8 million people (NBS, 2022 census) with an annual growth rate of 2.8%.


# Fisheries Statistic Mandate mandate.

- Statistical unit is under the Fishery Department which has the responsibility of collecting, storing of fisheries data, analysis, interpretation and submission of statistic report.
- Statistical report is being prepared and submitted monthly, quarterly, semi annually and annually.
- The data is submitted to Ministry, OCGS, BoT, Tuna Commission and FAO
- Total fishers Zanzibar(50,218) whereby Male 43,080 , Female 7,138 and Vessels 7,941 (ZFFS,2020)
